MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TRUTH AND TAXATION MEETING

Monday, December 12, 2016

The City of Starbuck held a public hearing on Monday, December 12, 2016 at 6:43 pm at the Starbuck Community Center located at 307 E 5th Street in Starbuck, MN. Present: Mayor Swenson; Councilmember: Gorder, Swensrud, Katzenmeyer, and Razink as well as City Clerk, Andrew Langholz; absent: none. Quorum is present.

Mayor Swenson stated that the City Council set a preliminary budget levy at 5% in September 2016. He then stated that this hearing is held to allow citizens to provide input and for the Council to field concerns. Mayor Swenson then opened the meeting up to the public for comment.

No public comment was made.

Mayor Swenson said that the proposed 5% levy was in part to cover a lawn mower, contribute to purchasing a new ambulance for the City of Starbuck, and accounting for line items that had previously not been accounted for.

No further discussion was held.
