MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING: Wellhead Protection Plan

Monday, March 11, 2019

The City of Starbuck held a public hearing on Monday, March 11 at 6:46 pm at the Starbuck Community Center located at 307 E 5th Street in Starbuck, MN. Present: Mayor Swenson; Councilmember: Spychalla, Razink, Taffe and Thompson. Absent: None. Quorum is present.

Mayor Swenson explained that this hearing was being held to discuss the Wellhead Protection Plan for the City of Starbuck. Paul Strong of WSN presented an overview of this plan including how the plan was created, opportunities to make the plan better, and strategies for improvement. He stressed that maintaining good records of City wells is important. Mr. Strong stated that once the plan is approved, yearly grants of \$10,000 are available from the MN Dept of Health to implement the plan.

There were no public comments. Mr. Strong said as there were no comments, the Council could approve the plan at their next meeting.

No further discussion was held. Mayor Swenson closed the public hearing at 7:07 p.m.
