1. Call the Meeting to Order at 5:30 p.m.

2. Consent Agenda:

- a. Approve Agenda - Motion to approve agenda. **Motion by Gorder, Second by Taffe. Motion Carried 4-0.**

3. City Marina Issues:

- a. Pre-Inspection

Clerk Benson and Mayor Swenson gave an overview of the entire history of the Marina treatments, the discovery of corrosion, and actions taken so far to mitigate the actions in the future.

- b. AIS Treatment

DNR and Minnewaska Lake Association handled the treatment of Starry Stone-wart. The City of Starbuck had no influence in the decision making process.

4. New Bike Path:

- a. Bids Received Bid came in too high. Motion to Reid the project. **Motion by Gorder; Second by Razink. Motion carried 4-0.**

5. Council Response to Correspondence

- a. A citizen spoke about the corrosion in the Marina. **Clerk Benson corrected several statements and explained the future actions.**
- b. Several Citizens spoke of Park Land Use. Citizens spoke in favor of use of the park, providing proper legal allowances.
