**MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING:**

**Conditional Use Permit – Request to Bring in Fill and Complete Excavation Needed to Construct a 25’ Lighthouse and an 8’ to 10’ Path on City Owned Land Located on the South Side of the Starbuck Marina which is Part of the Shoreland District**

The City of Starbuck held a public hearing on March 11, 2024, at 6:39pm at the Starbuck Community Center located at 307 E 5<sup>th</sup> Street in Starbuck, MN. Present: Mayor Swenson; Councilmembers: Taffe, Baukol and Christensen Present. Gorder-Absent. Quorum is present.

Mayor Swenson explained that this hearing was being held to discuss a Conditional Use Permit. This permit would allow the city to bring in fill and complete excavation needed to construct a 25’ Lighthouse and an 8’ to 10’ path on city owned land located on the south side of the Starbuck Marina. This land is part of the city’s shoreland district. This lighthouse would replace the old lighthouse on the north side of the marina which was destroyed in a 2022 storm.

The council was asked what the path to the lighthouse be made of. Mayor Swenson said the city would be using pavers that were left from the 2020 road project. The city will also be reusing steel from the roof at the wastewater plant to keep costs down.

With no further comments the hearing was closed at 6:40pm.
