**MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING:**

**Request to Vacate a Dedicated ROW Located South of 117 E 5<sup>th</sup> St and North of East Depot Ln.  
Starbuck Locker Location**

**Tuesday, October 15, 2024**

The City of Starbuck held a public hearing on Tuesday, October 15, 2024, at 6:35 pm at the Starbuck Community Center located at 307 E 5<sup>th</sup> Street in Starbuck, MN. Present: Mayor Swenson; Councilmembers: Taffe, Baukol, Goder Present. Christensen-Absent. Quorum is present.

Mayor Swenson explained that this hearing was being held to see if there were any public comments regarding a request to vacate the Dedicated ROW between 117 E. 5<sup>th</sup> St. and North of East Depot Ln. This section is approximately 202' x 34'. The Starbuck Locker would like to use this portion of the ROW to rebuild the starbuck locker that was destroyed by fire in July of 2024. A portion of the old structure had been built on this ROW. The legal description of this parcel is:

All that part of the public street which runs generally east and west and lies between the southerly boundary line of Lot 3 through 6 of Block 59 of the Original Plat of the City of Starbuck and the northerly boundary line of the property described in Book 119 Deeds, Page 510 as recorded in the office of the Pope County Recorder.

Mathias Briard, owner of the Starbuck Locker, addressed the council to say he had received his building plans and would like to get started with the project as soon as possible but needed approval for the vacation of the ROW.

With no further comments the public hearing was closed at 6:40pm.
